

Submission Guidelines

1. Submit original, unpublished papers online in Word and PDF formats.
2. Abstracts should be 300–400 words and must include keywords.
3. Full papers should be 3,000–4,000 words.
4. Full papers must include: Title, Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Study Objectives, Research Methodology, Data Analysis, Discussion of Findings, Recommendations, Conclusion and References in APA 7th style.
5. Manuscripts should be typed in English (Times New Roman, Font Size 12) or Hindi (Mangal/Unicode, Font Size 12).
6. Papers exceeding 10% plagiarism will be rejected during screening.
7. Submissions after the deadline will not be accepted.

AWARDS

- Awards will be given in two categories: Paper Presentation and Poster Presentation.
- In each category, three best papers and posters will be selected for awards.

Please note: Awards are applicable only for on-site (offline) paper/poster presenters.

About the College

Raja Shiv Prasad College, Jharia, is a Constituent unit permanently affiliated to Binod Bihari Mahto Koyalanchal University, Dhanbad currently located at Belgaria, Dhanbad, Jharkhand. Established in 1949, it holds the distinction of being the oldest college in Dhanbad district and surrounding coal belt region. The college was founded by Raja Kali Prasad Singh, the then Raja of Jharia, who recognized the need for higher education in this educationally backward area. Named in memory of his father, Raja Shiv Prasad Singh, the college was set up through a trust to provide accessible education to the local population. RSP College began its journey in 1951 when it secured temporary affiliation with Patna University. It gained permanent affiliation from Bihar University in 1952 and later became affiliated with Ranchi University in 1960. Since 1992, R. S. P. College, Jharia was affiliated to Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribagh. At present the College is permanently affiliated to Binod Bihari Mahato Koyalanchal University, Dhanbad since 2018. The college is registered under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act and has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a "B" grade (CGPA 2.59), reflecting its commitment to academic quality.

About the Seminar
